Chràthaich Wind Farm

Pre-application consultation is to be undertaken in advance of a planning application to Highland Council for a prospective wind farm (and associated infrastructure) on land at Corrimony Farm, approximately 7km southeast of Cannich, 7km northwest of Invermoriston, 12km north of Fort Augustus, and 13km southwest of Drumnadrochit.

Details of the wind farm plans will be available to be viewed online and downloaded at the following website: www.chrathaichwindfarm.co.uk from 10th October until 28th October 2022.

An online public consultation event will be held on the same website on 25th October 2022 between the hours of 2.00pm and 7.00pm. During this online event, members of the public will have the opportunity to ask questions and provide feedback to a member of the development team using live chat.
